RE: Known DNA Profiles (Exemplars)

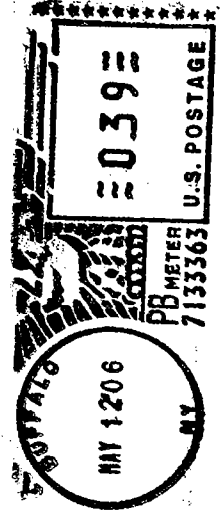
