PROCLAMATION NO. 2007-00003 DPS # 02767206

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME:

WHEREAS, JAMES DOUGLAS WALLER, TDCJ#350596, D.O.B. 06/06/1956, was sentenced in Criminal District Court No. 4 of Dallas County, Texas on February 1, 1983, to serve a 30 year sentence in the Institutional Division of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice and a \$10,000 fine for the offense of Aggravated Sexual Abuse, Cause No. F82-91294-TK;

AND WHEREAS, on the basis of new evidence, the District Judge of Criminal District Court No. 4 of Dallas County, Texas, found evidence that of James Douglas Waller would not have been convicted in Cause No. F82-91294-TK;

AND WHEREAS, the District Attorney for Dallas County, Bill Hill, the Judge of Criminal District Court No. 4 John Creuzot, and the Dallas Chief of Police David Kunkle joined in recommending a Pardon for Innocence.

AND WHEREAS, the Board of Pardons and Paroles has recommended a Full Pardon for Innocence.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK PERRY, Governor of the State of Texas, by virtue of the authority vested in me under the Constitution and laws of this State, and acting upon the recommendation of the Texas Board of Pardons and Paroles, do hereby grant unto the said JAMES DOUGLAS WALLER

A FULL PARDON FOR INNOCENCE ON HIS OFFENSE ABOVE SET OUT IN CAUSE NO. F82-91294-TK, CRIMINAL DISTRICT COURT No. 4, DALLAS COUNTY, TEXAS.
